Israel meets Frankfurt:

Shalom BBK – ...a „Rendezvous“ for the 60th anniversary

The 60th anniversary of the foundation of the state of Israel is celebrated this year. In line with the festivities, artelier24 has conceived an extraordinary international exhibit:

Under the patronage of mayor Petra Roth, the Israeli artist Ben Rotman will be guest at the premises of BBK Frankfurt (Bundes Bildender Künstler).

Rotman's three-dimensional looking works show intensive coloring and vitality. The artist deals with both cultural and political themes. Apart from other European cities, he has already exhibited in New York. Rotman says about his creative work: „Painting with a computer mouse needs much more creativity than classical painting.“

Rotman will be "framed" by two BBK artists - Irene Kau and Karin Goetz. Irene Kaus works are contradictory. You can find either calm, geometrical forms or fantastic figures. „My paintings express the power of spiritual energy that can move a lot of things.“ says Kau. Karin Goetz presents object art. She works amongst others with fiberglass and wire. She creates filigree figures that show a technical quality. Projections overlay Goetz's objects that remind the viewer of garments.

The exhibit in Frankfurt will not be the only show. There will be a corresponding art event in Israel in 2009.

The exhibition in Frankfurt will be curated by Marcus Graf and Marcus Heuser.

Guest speaker of the evening will be Amnon Rimon. Since February Amnon Rimon has been director of "State of Israel Bonds" for Germany, Switzerland and Austria. State of Israel Bonds are securities, issued by the State of Israel.

Amnon Rimon was born in Israel as son of German jews. He was a career officer in the Israel Defense Forces (IDF). Afterwards he worked for two decades in the business sector and for several charity organisations in Israel and abroad. He also lived and worked for several years in Germany.
